

Practice Field Reservation, Daylight Savings, and Other Field Information

Practice Field Reservation

On team assignment night each coach will receive a Practice Field Reservation Form. In order to assign fields in a timely manner, the SBSC Field Coordinator needs to receive this form as soon as possible. You can return this form in the following ways:

- Complete it at Team Assignment night a give it to the Field Coordinator.
- Access the form at the SBSC website (www.solanabeachsoccerclub.com) under the Fields & Equipment section. Complete it and email it or fax it to the Field Coordinator.

The Field Coordinator will make his/her best efforts to provide each coach their first choice of field and time, but second and third choices are required in the event of high demand at a specific field and time slot. The Field Coordinator or your Division Coordinator will notify you of the day / time slot(s) you are assigned.

Daylight Savings Time

When the shift off Daylight Savings Time occurs in November (2 a.m. on the first Sunday of November). Coaches with 5 PM practice times will have to move to earlier practice times of 3:30 or 4:00 PM. The Field Coordinator will work with the Boys and Girls Coordinators and coaches to reschedule practice times and locations. Please be prepared to share your field with additional teams after the shift.

Practice Field Priority

The SBSC Board reserves the fields that are used for our teams to practice. Our teams have sole use of these fields during the date range and time blocks that the SBSC has reserved. If other organizations are using the fields during these periods, please contact the Field Coordinator so that we can contact the other organizations to make them aware of the SBSC reservations of these fields.

Practice Field Cleanup

The SBSC uses fields that belong to local schools and the city for practices and games. In order to maintain the best relationship with the schools and city so that we can continue to access these fields, we ask that coaches be certain that all trash (particularly forgotten water bottles) is cleaned up after practices and games.

Portable Toilet Access

The SBSC makes portable toilets available at the Solana Vista, Skyline and Solana Beach CDC fields. When not in use during practices and games, they MUST be locked. Each toilet has a combination lock, and your Coordinator will provide you with the combination for the current season. If no other team is on the field at the end of your practice or game, PLEASE BE CERTAIN THAT THE TOILET IS LOCKED. Portable toilets at Earl Warren are provided by the school and should be accessible during practice and game hours, and if teams are using the field at La Colonia for practice, public restrooms are available – if you are unable to access the toilets at either of these fields, please contact the SBSC Field Coordinator.

Game Schedules, Field Preparation, and Rainy Day Procedure

Game Schedules

The first game for the 2009 season will be on Saturday, September 12, 2009. The final game of the 2009 season will be on November 21, 2009.

In order to provide a full schedule of play, the SBSC games with other Cal South leagues in our area (Cardiff, Encinitas, Rancho Santa Fe, etc.). The scheduling of SBSC team games is part of a larger process including these other recreational leagues as well as the scheduling of Presidio League competitive games. The SBSC makes every effort to provide game schedules to its coaches as far in advance of the season start as possible. Often, due to the complexity of the larger process, schedules are not available until a few weeks before the start of the season. The SBSC Boys and Girls Coordinators will provide the schedules as soon as they become available.

Field Preparation

The Field Coordinator ensures that fields are ready for play each Saturday. He/she schedules for goal posts and nets to be set up and removed at the end of the day and for fields to be lined as needed. If you encounter any problems or have any concerns about the condition of a field, please contact the field coordinator.

Official FIFA dimensions as of July 2005 are:

- Length: Minimum 100 yards to Maximum 130 yards (300' to 390')
- Width: Minimum 50 yards to Max. 100 yards (150' to 300')

The following dimensions are used for SBSC fields:

6 - Solana Vista West (6 v 6)	180' (60% of FIFA)	120' (60% of FIFA)
7 - Solana Beach CDC (4 v 4)	30 yards	20 yards
